What Are Regional and Local Forums?

Regional Forums originated in 1975 at the suggestion of Dr. Jack Norris, then Chair of the General Service Board of Alcoholics Anonymous. They were to be weekend sharing and informational sessions designed to help the General Service Board, A.A. World Services, Inc., the Grapevine Corporate Board, the Grapevine Staff, and the General Service Office Staff stay in touch with A.A. members, trusted servants and newcomers to service throughout the A.A. service structure.

What happens at Regional Forums?

Since the U.S./Canada service structure is composed of eight regions, a Regional Forum is held in alternate years in each region on a rotating basis. The Southwest Regional Forum rotates among the eleven Area in our Region. That means that the SW Regional Forum only comes to Area 46, New Mexico once every 22 years. Our turn in the rotation happens in 2025. It will be our turn to host attendees from our Area as well as the other 10 Areas in our Region. We will host 400 or more of our closest friends from around the SW Region. What a party we will have.

Members of the Board of Directors, GSO staff, and other employees from the General Service Office travel to our region. They present informational topics, host workshops, and are available to meet members of our Region and answer our questions. If you ever wondered who "They" are back in New York, now is your chance to meet some of them.
